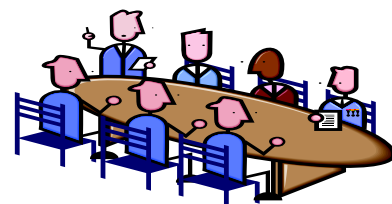

From Jamestown:

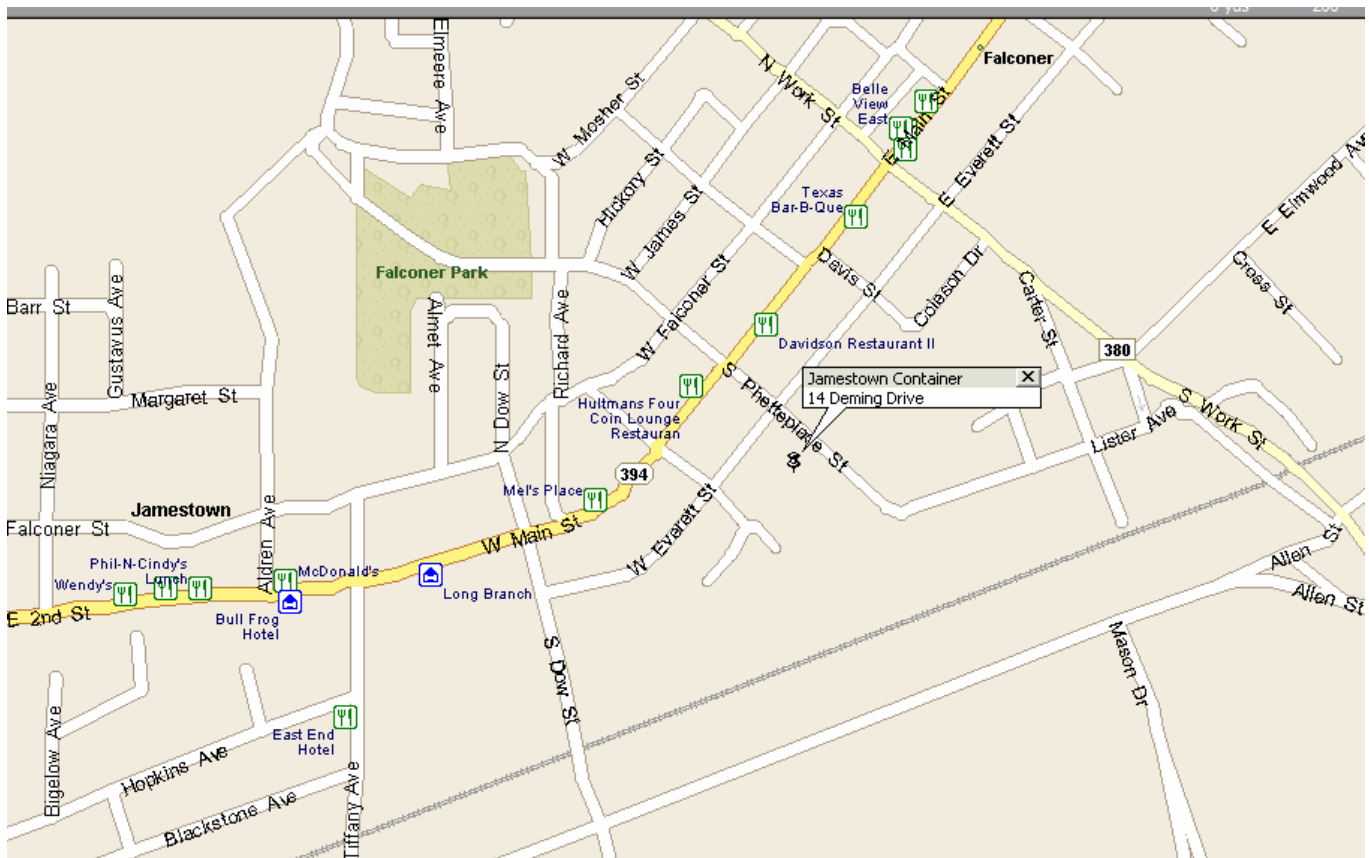
Take 2nd Street in Jamestown East towards Falconer. Go to Phetteplace St. and turn Right. Go to Deming Drive, (It's the drive way to Jamestown Container) and turn Right. Attendees should go to the Main Door on the left side of the building.

From Bradford:

Take 219 North to 86. Go West, towards Jamestown, NY and get off at exit 13. Follow the road around to E. Main St. and turn Right. Follow East Main St. to Phetteplace St. and turn Right. Go to Deming Drive, (It's the drive way to Jamestown Container) and turn Right. Attendees should go to the Main Door on the left side of the building.

From Warren:

Take 62 North to W. Main St. (60) Turn Right. Got to Frewsburg to Falconer St and Turn Left and go towards Falconer. Go to West Everett St. (Just before 394), Turn left and go to Phetteplace St. and turn Right. Go to Deming Drive, (It's the drive way to Jamestown Container) and turn Right. Attendees should go to the Main Door on the left side of the building.
